In compliance with Title III of the Energy Conservation and Production Act of 1976, as amended, this is to certify that the State of New Jersey has adopted the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC)/2009 for low-rise residential buildings, along with the ASHRAE 90.1-2007 for commercial buildings and all other residential buildings not covered under the IECC/2009. Enclosed please find a copy of the New Jersey Register (NJR), dated September 7, 2010, which includes the adoption of the IECC/2009 and ASHRAE 90.1-2007, as part of New Jersey's Uniform Construction Code, N.J.A.C. 5:23-3.18 (see NJR page 2061).
